# ELIGIBILITY

- **By C.I.F. mandate and our school policy, an athlete must have and maintain a 2.0 G.P.A. All KCHS athletes must be students in order to be athletes. The reason students go to school is to become educated and playing on an interscholastic team is but one of the opportunities and privileges students have through education.**

**Any athlete whose grades should begin to drop at any time during the season will also have their grades checked on a weekly basis. Every coach will receive a record of his or her athletes who are on weekly check. Those weekly grades will be communicated to the parents, and to the athlete upon request.**

- **\* to maintain his academic eligibility in the maintaining of their grades. Teachers are not to be asked for make up work just to get eligible to play in a contest.**
- **Many of our coaches are also teachers on staff and are genuinely committed to the success of their athletes. They offer opportunities for extra help as well as assistance in completing assignments. See your individual coaches for more details.**
