THIS WEEK IN FIRST GRADE:

Bible: Lesson 26—Trusting God

Memory Verse—Deuteronomy 31:8

Please review memory verse every night in preparation for the oral test on Friday

Penmanship: This week we will be working creating *neatly written* sentences.

Math: This week I will be introducing the twelve addition family, and carrying to the tens column. I will also be reviewing greater than and less than, adding three numbers with two digits, skip counting (2, 3, 5, 10), measurements, calendar facts, temperature, story problems, and money.

Phonics: This week I will be introducing the special sound and clue word “tain” in mountain. I will be introducing contractions. I will also be reviewing syllables, compound words, prefixes, root words and suffixes, doubling consonants, dropping silent e, changing y to and i before adding a suffix that begins with an e. dividing words between prefixes and root words and root words and suffixes, and Phonics Charts 6-13.
