Due: **Friday, August 26, 2011**

John 1:1-5 **1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2** He was with God in the beginning. **3** Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. **4** In him was life, and that life was the light of men. **5** The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.

Matt 6:19-21 **19** "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. **20** But store up for yourselves treasures in

heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Luke 9:23-25 **23** Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. **24** For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. **25** What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit his very self ?

Due: **Friday, September 30th, 2011**

Luke 6:37-38 **37** "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. **38** Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

John 14:15-17 **15** "If you love me, you will obey what I command. **16** And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever-- **17** the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

Due: **Friday, October 14th, 2011**

Acts 2:2-4 **2** Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. **3** They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. **4** All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Due: **Friday, October 21st, 2011**

Proverbs 6:16-19 **16** There are six things the LORD hates, seven that are detestable to him: **17** haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, **18** a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, **19** a false witness who pours out lies and a man who stirs up dissension among brothers.

Due: **Friday, October 28th, 2011**

Galatians 3:28-29 **28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. **29** If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Due: **Friday, November 4th, 2011**

2 Timothy 4:2-4 **2** Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction. **3** For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. **4** They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths.

Due: **Wednesday, November 9th, 2011**

Romans 1:19-20 **18** The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, **19** since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. **20** For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities--his eternal power and divine nature--have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

Due: **Friday, November 18th, 2011**

Romans 8:1-2 **1** Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, **2** because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

Due: **Friday, December 2nd, 2011**

Romans 12:1-2 **1** Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. **2** Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Psalms 51:10-12 **10** Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. **11** Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. **12** Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me

Due: **Thursday, December 15th, 2011**

1 Corinthians 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 **4** Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. **5** It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. **6** Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. **7** It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. **8** Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52 **51** Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed-- **52** in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

Due: **Friday, January 20th, 2012**

Malachi 3:10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it.

Due: **Friday, February 3th, 2012**

Galatians 5:22-23 **22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Due: **Thursday, February 9th, 2012**

James 1:13-14 **13** When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; **14** but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed.

Due: **Friday, February 17th, 2012**

Phil 4:6-7 **6** Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. **7** And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Due: **Thursday, February 23rd, 2012**

Colossians 3:12-14 **12** Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. **13** Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. **14** And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

1 Thessalonians 5:14-17 **14** And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. **15** Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else. **16** Be joyful always; **17** pray continually

Due: **Thursday, March 8th, 2012**

1 Timothy 4:12 **12** Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.

Due: **Friday, March 16th, 2012**

2 Timothy 2:20-21 **20** In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. **21** If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

Due: **Friday, March 23rd, 2012**

Titus 2:11-14 **11** For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. **12** It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, **13** while we wait for the blessed hope--the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, **14** who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.

Due: **Friday, April 13th, 2012**

2 Corinthians 5:17-18 **17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! **18**All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

Due: **Thursday, April 19th, 2012**

Hebrews 11:1-3 **1** Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. **2** This is what the ancients were commended for. **3** By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

Due: **Friday, April 27th, 2012**

Hebrews 12:5-6 **5** And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: "My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, **6** because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son."

James 1:2-4 **2** Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, **3** because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. **4** Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

James 2:14 **14** What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save him?

Due: **Friday, May 18th, 2012**

Psalm Chapter 1:1-6 **1** Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. **2** But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night. **3** He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. **4** Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away. **5** Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. **6** For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
